We wish to bring under your kind attention that as per the university guidelines, we follow the curriculum which is in compliance with the latest model curriculum provided by AICTE. The curriculum includes all the crucial core courses necessary for competitive exams and placements.

As part of our institutional process, we have gathered curriculum related feedback from various stakeholders, including students, parents, alumni, faculty members, and employers. Based on the feedback received, we have identified some recommendations that we would like to propose for the AKTU curriculum for the upcoming academic session of 2022-23. The summary of the recommendations is provided below:

- 1. B.Tech Electronics & Communication Engineering:** Antenna & Wave Propagation lab may be included in curriculum.
- 2. Master of Computer Application:** Courses related to Social Media Management & Security may be added in the curriculum.
